## Tier 1

Literacy	Mathematics
Employ explicit vocabulary instruction.	Use manipulatives and multisensory tools.
Provide varied texts or supplementary materials (leveled text).	Employ explicit vocabulary instruction.
Scaffold writing instruction.	Devote time to basic arithmetic facts.
Use the think-pair-share strategy.	Teach customized self-correction checklists.
Reinforce use of text features for comprehension and written expression.	Use a calculator.
Teach mnemonic cues.	Reduce the number of problems per page.
Evaluate student progress with the use of formative assessments for reading and writing.	Use simple, consistent language.
Teach QAR strategy.	Use the concrete-pictorial-abstract progression.
Use the Reading-For-Meaning Strategy.	Practice creating a plan to solve a problem.
Implement reciprocal teaching.	Paraphrase the problem.
Reinforce guided writing.	Develop answer-checking practices (e.g., predictions).
Teach systematic note taking strategies.	Enlarge symbols to cue students.
	Use cover-copy-compare.
	Have students maintain a "Math Journal."
	Use systematic note taking.
	Reinforce the use of think-alouds.
