

Semantic Feature Analysis

Purpose: Distinguishing characteristics of related terms

Typically, the features of a class go across the top and the members of the class go down the left side. Be sure to leave one or two empty vertical and horizontal cells for students to add their own.

Students typically do this at the end of a unit. It should always be done in a small group discussion, not as a worksheet. It can be done with any age group and in any content area.
